Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Talbot County Health Department (TCHD) is working with your child's school to offer FREE seasonal flu shots. Please remember that a parent or guardian must be present with all elementary aged school children in order for their child to receive the flu shot. Children in Pre-K through Fifth grade will only be offered flu shots during evening clinics and 1 Saturday clinic. If a parent or guardian is unable to take their elementary aged child to the evening or Saturday clinic and sends the child with another adult, then written consent signed by the parent or guardian must be sent with the adult who will bring your child to the flu clinic.
