

President's Award

The President's Award was established by Susan Delean-Botkin and Dominic Terrone to support local students who may not already be in line to receive many awards and scholarships. Rather this award should be given to a student who stands out for his or her exemplary effort, and/or how he or she may have faced and overcome unusual challenges. The student should also have demonstrated a commitment to impacting the community both now and in the future through service learning efforts.

An award in the amount of \$1,000 will be made to one student at Easton High and one student St. Michaels Middle High each year beginning with the class of 2021 and continuing for at least 10 years or as long as funding is available. The award may be continued for two or four years upon application for subsequent funding.

Eligibility Requirements and Guidelines:

- The student must be a graduating senior from Easton High School or Saint
 Michaels Middle High School, planning to pursue post-secondary education at a
 Maryland college, university, or career/technical education program.
- 2. The student must have a 2.5 grade point average or better.
- 3. The award may not exceed the cost of the program.
- The selection of the recipient will be based on the criteria outlined above and awarded at the discretion of the high school administration – Principal, School Counselor, etc.
- 5. Checks will be made out directly to the college, university or technical program that the student will be attending.
