The high school honor society hosts a water station during the St. Michaels Running Festival. The students set up a tent, handing out cups of water as runners pass by their table during the marathon.


SERVICE-LEARNING HOURS

- Court-mandated community service
- Church related activities that promote church doctrine, i.e. nursery, Bible School
