Dorothy Webb Black was a tireless fighter for human and civil rights in Talbot County. Her extraordinary commitment to serve humanity by feeding the hungry, clothing the naked and providing shelter to the homeless is still clearly seen daily at the Neighborhood Service Center, which she founded.

The Talbot County Branch of the NAACP has partnered with the Mid-Shore Community Foundation to establish the Dorothy Webb Black Memorial Scholarship Fund in honor of her tireless commitment to our organization. Each year, awards will be made to assist local students with college book expenses. This year, four (4) students of color graduating from Talbot County high schools who have demonstrated a commitment to community service will be selected to receive five hundred dollars (\$500.00) each. Payment will be made directly to the college or university of the recipient's choice, upon receipt of confirmation of the recipient's choice.

Book Award Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. The student must be a graduating student of color, planning to enter an accredited university, college or two-year community college the semester following graduation.
- 2. The student must graduate with a 2.5 grade point average or better in academic subjects at the time he/she is submitting the application.
- 3. The student must have a history of community service.
- 4. The student must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from persons other than relatives. One should be from a teacher/counselor and one from a member of a community service organization in which the student has been involved.
- 5. The scholarship selection committee will interview students, to be considered for the award.

Application Procedure:

- 1. The student must secure an application from the guidance counselor or any member of the NAACP/ scholarship committee.
- 2. The application must be **typed or computer generated**.
- 3. Letters of recommendation must be in a sealed envelope with signature across the seal.
- 4. The completed package should include the following:
 - a. Completed application
 - b. Two letters of recommendation
 - c. Official school transcript
 - d. Personal essay explaining which of your service learning activities was most meaningful to you, and why.
- The application package should be hand-delivered or postmarked on or before 3/27,2024 to:
