Award amount: \$500

Award description:

Each year, St. Luke UM Church, Bellevue, MD, a nonprofit organization will award the Robbie Batson Memorial Scholarship to a St. Michaels High School Senior who will be attending an accredited institution of higher learning. Scholarships are for one year and are awarded on the basis of academic achievement, community service, school activities, and student career goals.

Scholarship applicant requirements:

- Must be a resident of Talbot County, attending St. Michaels High School.
- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must be admitted to an accredited institution of higher learning.
- Must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher.
- Must submit a completed application form plus: two letters of recommendation from non-family members, a resume (containing academic achievements, community service, and school activities), a transcript, a copy of Senior Year grades, an acceptance letter from the college you believe you will attend, and an essay

Selection Process:

- Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee, using a rubric to score the applications.
- References may be contacted if necessary.
- The committee will announce the winner at the Senior Awards Night in May.
