(TWM) Scholarship Tilghman Watermen's Museum

The Tilghman Watermen's Museum has created a scholarship for the Tilghman area watermen's community through their endowment to the Tilghman Watermen's Museum.

The Scholarship will be awarded to a deserving undergraduate student furthering their education at an accredited technical school, two year or four year college.

Eligibility

To be eligible the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- A.) Graduate from Tilghman Elementary School or live in the Tilghman Elementary School District as defined by the Talbot County Public Schools.
- B.) Have been a resident of Talbot County, Maryland for at least one year preceding the date of the award.
- C.) Have been accepted as a full time student as defined by the recipient's attending school.
- D.) Have a minimum of 2.75 Grade Point Average.
- E.) Is a graduating senior from a Talbot County Public High School.

Number of Scholarships

There can be up to three senior recipients from Talbot County Public High Schools.

Criteria for Award

The recipient will be selected by the TWM Scholarship Committee and approved by the TWM Board. All applications will be scored with a scoring rubric that aligns with the application.

Value of Award

The recipients that are honored with this scholarship will receive \$1,000.00 paid to his/her institution.

Application

A student who wishes to be considered must send an application & supporting documentation to the attention of the TWM Scholarship Committee PO Box 344, Tilghman, Maryland 21671 and must be postmarked no later than April 1 of the year for which the student is asking to be considered. Applications are available in both Talbot County high schools guidance counselor's offices. Announcement of recipient will be named in May of each year.

All applicants must use the official Tilghman Watermen's Museum Scholarship Form. No other forms will be accepted.

The following supporting documents must be submitted with the application form:

- A.) Copy of the student's current high school transcript
- B.) Copy of acceptance letter from an accredited institution of higher learning.
- C.) One page letter of recommendation from a non-family member addressing the student's character.
- D.) A two page maximum 10 point font, double spaced and 1 inch margins essay by the applicant. The essay should address why you want to attend a college or training school and what are the experiences that led you to this decision such as volunteer work, class or internship and what you gained from this involvement.
